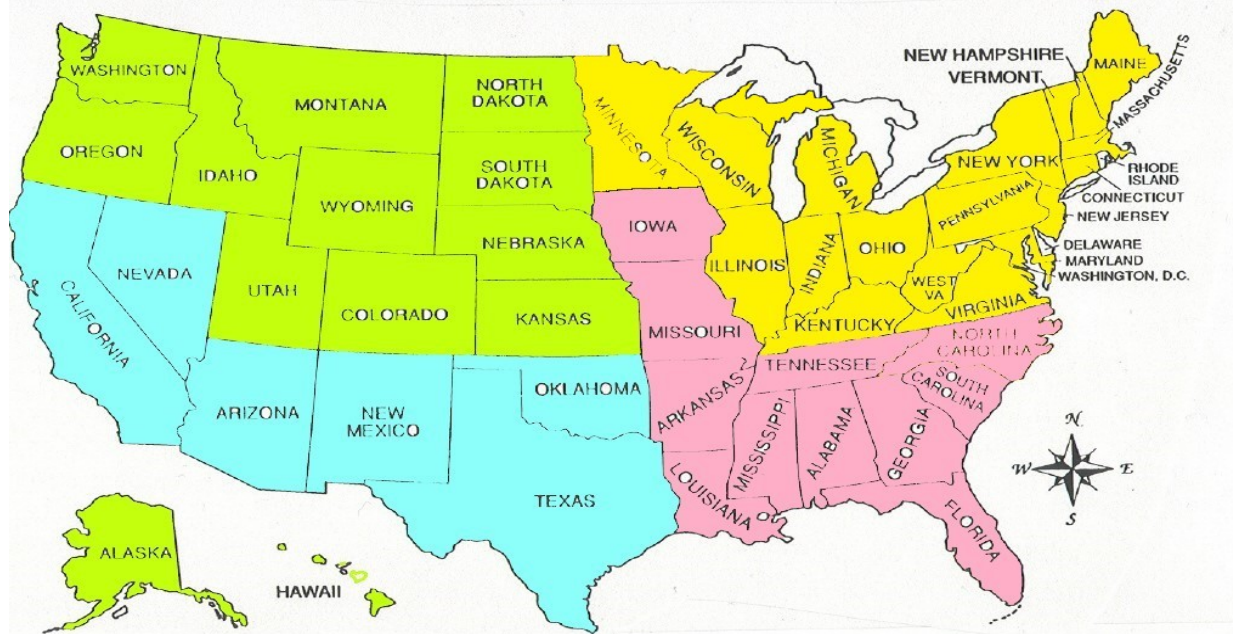


Miniature Hereford Junior Nationals Junior Committee

Committee Structure

1. Committee shall be made up of no more than EIGHT Junior members.
2. Committee shall have an assigned MHJN Committee Member Advisor.
3. Committee shall be composed of TWO members from each region, Seat A and Seat B.
4. Seat A shall be a two-year appointment for 2019-2021.
5. Seat B shall be a one-year appointment for 2019-2020.
6. Seat A will be a two-year appointment after 2021 and Seat B will be a two-year appointment after 2020.
7. Applications for membership for 2019-2020 shall be reviewed and approved by the current MHJN committee.
8. Seat B members shall be elected at the 2020 MHJN show by members of their respective region. Elections will occur at MHJN shows held in even years.
9. Seat A members shall be elected at the 2021 MHJN show by members of the respective region. Elections will occur at MHJN shows held in odd years.
10. Regions that do not receive enough qualifying applications shall be filled by overage applications from other regions as a one-year appointment. Upon receipt of a qualified candidate an election will be held at the upcoming MHJN show.
11. Region 1 is shaded in Green.
12. Region 2 is shaded in Blue.
13. Region 3 is shaded in Pink.
14. Region 4 is shaded in Yellow.
15. Elected Junior Committee members shall be allowed ONE free entry to MHJN show per year.



Eligibility

1. Open to High School freshman until completion of Junior show eligibility.
2. Must have participated in a prior Miniature Hereford Junior National event.
3. Members must have proof of a 2.5 or higher school GPA with no major disciplinary infractions.
4. Prospective members are required to provide a letter of recommendation from a member of the community.

Responsibilities of Members

1. Members are required to participate (volunteer at a minimum) in MHJN shows during their term.
2. Members shall communicate with other Junior and Pre-Junior members for feedback to be provided to the MHJN Committee for future MHJN show planning.
3. Members are required to participate with multiple tasks at MHJN such as new member meeting, contests, show ring assistance, etc.
4. Members must actively participate in fund raising efforts and take an initiative to seek new opportunities.
5. Members should conduct themselves as representatives of MHJN at all times. Major school disciplinary actions or conduct unbecoming will be grounds for removal from the Junior Committee.

Application Process for Prospective Committee Members

1. All applications shall be submitted electronically to obie105@hotmail.com by entry deadline for the MHJN Event, which is June 20, 2020.
2. High School transcript with a minimum 2.5 GPA requirement and no major (suspension, expulsion, etc.) past disciplinary infractions.
3. Letter of recommendation from a respected community member or school official. This person should not be a family member or relative.
4. Photograph. Headshot only submitted electronically. This can/will be used in publications of the MHJN both in print and online.
